Definition of minor and severe complication according to GynOp

Minor	Severe
Unforeseen event caused by the operation that has not lead to a contact with healthcare nor meet any criteria under severe.	Injury, disability and death as well as readmission to hospital exceeding one night, reoperation and impact on sick leave >1 month.
Unforeseen event caused by the operation that has resulted in intervention in the health care system but not hospitalization.	Accidental damage to vital organs (intestines, urinary tract, nerves and vessels) that occurred during or as a result of the surgery and required reoperation Dysfunction of vital organs as a result of the operation requiring hospitalization Reoperation due to a late complication of the primary surgery requiring hospitalization.
